Hints and Tips for Macs:

- Finder>Applications = Start> Programs on PC---Shows programs on Mac example Adobe, iWorks etc.
- Always close out of Safari or Web Browser by File Exit.
- Always drag flash drive icon to the trash can before removing or it could harm your data and the flash drive.
- Empty Browser History and Cache regularly to improve Infinite Campus performance. If everything on your Mac works except Grade Book (it just spins or nothing comes up), simply clearing the history and cache in your browser usually corrects the problem. 99.9% of Grade Book issues can be avoided by following this simple procedure at least once a week.
- Shut down your machine at least once per week to improve performance.
- iWorks has your programs like Microsoft Office.
 - Numbers = Excel
 - Pages = Word
 - These can be found by clicking on Finder>Applications>iWorks
 - When creating and saving documents with a Mac consider un-checking the box for Hide Extension and save document as Word or Excel etc. Otherwise when sending as attachment non-Mac users will be unable to open your attachments.
- Safari is Apple/Mac preferred web browser.
 - Safari is comparable to Internet Explorer or Mozilla Firefox.
 - Safari icon looks like a compass.
- When changing locations (wireless) from McCracken to Home etc. Click the Apple icon>scroll down to Location change to Automatic for anywhere other than in district. Be sure to change accordingly or you will not be able to access internet (wi-fi).
- Check for Software updates---click Apple () icon in top left corner>Software Updates. If update is needed it will show here. You simply click on the update to process. This will usually require plugging in.
- It is best to only charge computer when icon on your Tool Bar (at top of the screen) shows red.

 This will help battery life.

Hints and Tips for Macs:

• To find the IP address for your Mac: Click on Airport>Open Network Preferences>Your IP will be listed and usually begins with a 10.16....etc. (If we need to "remote" into your machine, we will need this information.)
